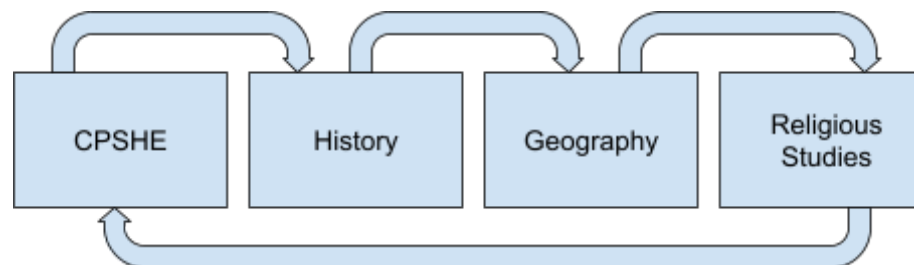


Humanities Curriculum Map Overview
