Talk to us about anything:

- If you feel upset, uncomfortable or worried, about anything at all (even if you think it is not important)
- If someone has hurt you physically, emotionally or mentally
- If you are being threatened, forced or coerced to do something that makes you feel uncomfortable
- If someone has done something to you without your consent
- If you feel unsafe in school, at home or in public
- If you know of another pupil who is being hurt or upset/uncomfortable
- If you are scared or worried about going home

Who can you speak to if you feel worried or upset?

You can speak to any member of staff at School about anything that is worrying you. We also have a safeguarding team, who are here to listen, support and help you at any time of the school day.

How to tell us something

- Talk to any member of staff. Every student has at least one trusted adult in school which may be your form tutor, PSO, HOY or a teacher
